If there's a chemical emergency at the Depot, some schools will shelter students indoors.

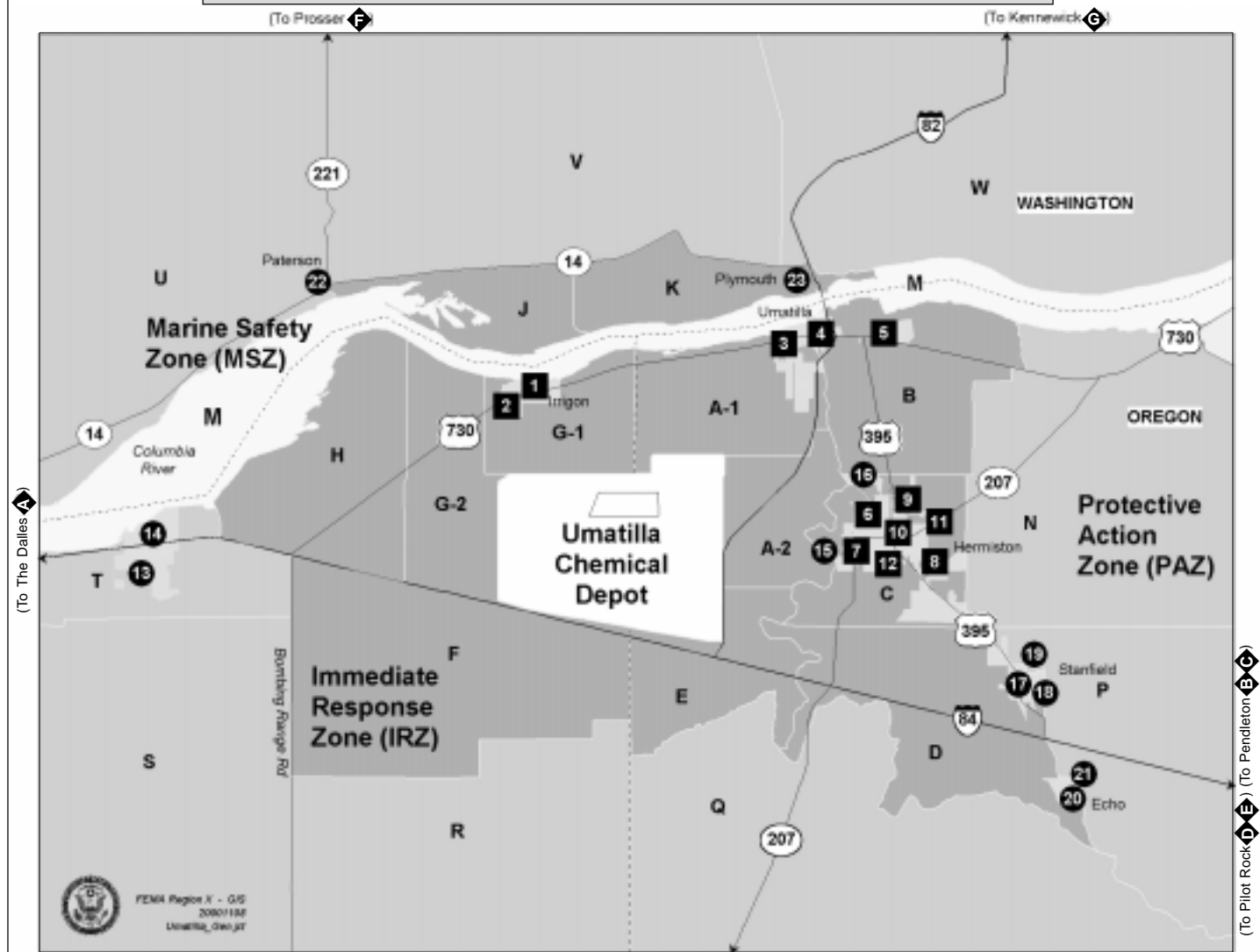
Others will bus students away from the area.
