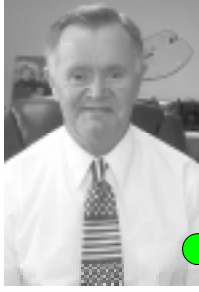
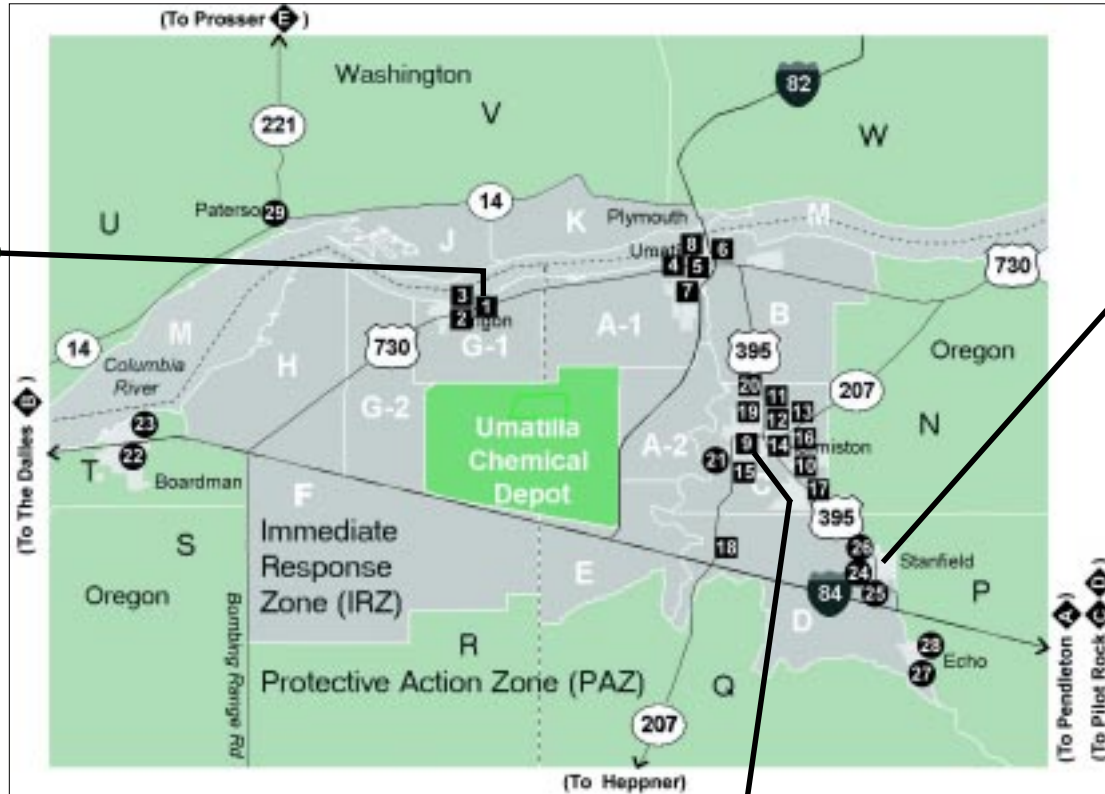


# Your schools and CSEPP
