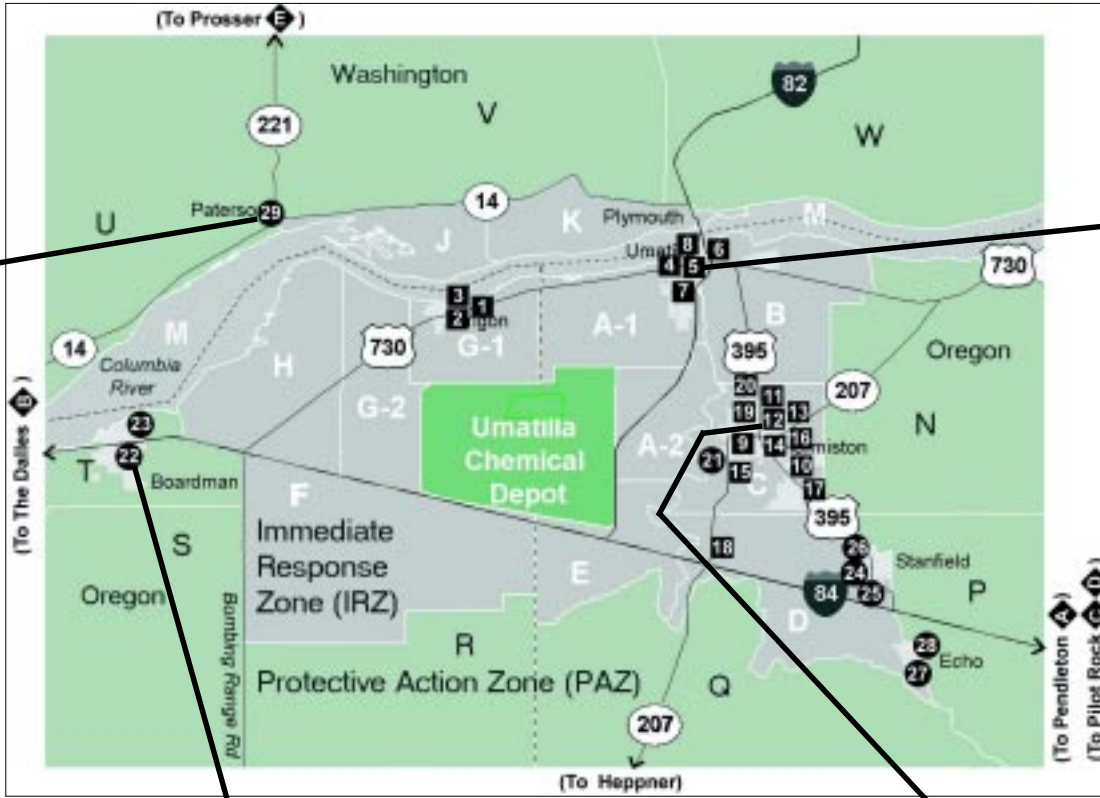


Your schools and CSEPP
