**SCRIPT**

Is that a siren test, or is there an emergency at the Umatilla Chemical Depot? Have you ever wondered?

CSEPP is making it easier for you to know the difference!

Beginning Tuesday, April 29th, the monthly CSEPP siren tests will use this new tone.

In a chemical emergency, you would hear this siren tone for three minutes, warning you to take protective action.

Be prepared. If you live or work in Oregon in Irrigon, Boardman, Umatilla, Hermiston, Stanfield, or Echo, or in Washington in Plymouth or Paterson -- know the siren warning tones and what to do.
