<p>Should you evacuate or shelter-in-place during a chemical emergency at the Umatilla Chemical Depot?</p> <p>The answer depends on <u>where</u> you are when alerted.</p> <p>In Washington near Plymouth or Paterson, evacuate north toward Prosser or the Tri-Cities.</p> <p>In Oregon near Umatilla, Hermiston, Stanfield, Echo, Boardman or Irrigon –shelter-in-place.</p> <p>Call CSEPP to find out how.</p> <p>In Oregon, call 1-877-367-2737.</p> <p>In Washington call 1-800-841-7953.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">###</p>
