Umatilla County names Acting Emergency Manager

Pendleton, Ore. – Effective December 1, 2005, Ray Denny will be the Acting Emergency Manager for Umatilla County. In this capacity he will act both as the Emergency Manager and Chemical Stockpile Emergency Preparedness Program (CSEPP) Manager.

Denny replaces Meg Capps who resigned effective November 18th. Umatilla County will begin an open recruitment process for the permanent position.

Denny has been employed as the Umatilla County Chemical Stockpile Emergency Preparedness Program (CSEPP) Planner since April 2004. Prior to joining CSEPP, Denny was the Umatilla County Soil and Water Conservation District Program Manager (1998 to 2004) and worked for the City of Hillsboro Utilities Program (1991 to 1994). He is also a volunteer with the East Umatilla Rural Fire Protection District.
