UMCDF Operations

- About 1,000 GB rockets remain to be processed. They should be destroyed within the next several days.
- Public risk from chemical munitions stored at Umatilla Chemical Depot has now been reduced by 91 percent. Demilitarization operations began at UMCDF in September 2004.
- Changeover from GB rockets to GB projectiles is expected to take about seven weeks.
